Finalists were selected from over 110 entries by the internationally renowned sculptor, Richard Hunt. The free public opening reception is Friday, March 18 from 6 pm to 9 pm. Robert Thurmer, Director of the University Art Gallery, Cleveland State University, will lead a gallery talk on Thursday, March 31 at 6 pm.
